Update – Ongoing Stock Issues/Shortages as at January 2025



# Information for prescribers – update 30 Jan 2025

### Current methylphenidate stock issues:

Methylphenidate formulations are experiencing global stock shortages in multiple strengths and formulations

- Teva and Concerta brands of methylphenidate ER have been affected since August 2024
- Rubifen SR (20mg) methylphenidate has become out of stock as at 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2025
- Ritalin LA no current stock issues
- Immediate release methylphenidate (Rubifen, Ritalin) no current stock issues
- Alternative ADHD stimulant options: dexamfetamine and lisdexamfetamine no current stock issues

### Methylphenidate release profiles differ between products

- Methylphenidate extended release Concerta, Teva 12 hour release profile
- Methylphenidate sustained release Rubifen SR 8 hour release profile
- Methylphenidate long acting Ritalin LA 8 hour release profile

# Update on Delays

- Rubifen SR 20mg is out of stock "for a short time" delays at the manufacturing plant have meant that the next shipment will be late expected to arrive mid-February, and then it will take another 1-2 weeks for stock to reach pharmacies around NZ.
- The next delivery of Teva ER has been delayed until February. Teva advises that restructuring in the Bulgarian Ministry of Health has delayed the issuing of export licences required. There is currently NO supply of Teva with the supplier, but further shipments are planned as per below table
- Concerta expecting further shipments as per below table

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# Things to know:

- Consider prescribing methylphenidate generically – this will enable the pharmacist to substitute whichever brand is available
- Please DO NOT start people with ADHD on either Teva or Concerta unless absolutely necessary. Consider alternative, shorter duration, methylphenidate formulations, while noting that Rubifen SR is on short supply

- Consider immediate release methylphenidate instead currently no stock issues
- Check the special authority matches the formulation you are prescribing (see above)
  - Medsafe have confirmed that the legal requirements to prescribe a
    methylphenidate presentation are satisfied regardless of whether the original
    specialist recommendation was written for "methylphenidate" or a specific
    presentation of methylphenidate
  - GPs and Nurse Practitioners can legally apply for an alternative special authority for a <u>methylphenidate</u> presentation, if needed, provided that all other relevant eligibility criteria are met
- Lisdexamfetamine has been listed on the pharmaceutical schedule since December 2024 as an alternative stimulant treatment option, however this requires special authority on the recommendation of a paediatrician or a psychiatrist this can be prescribed by GPs and Nurse Practitioners
- **Dexamfetamine** is another alternative ADHD stimulant treatment, can also be applied for via special authority on the recommendation of a paediatrician or a psychiatrist this can be prescribed by GPs and Nurse Practitioners
