

General Information:

Please use the Web Portal Community Probation Service Form to make a claim.

If a prescription is required, please print the CPS Pharmacy Form as an outbox document for the patient to take to the pharmacy with their prescription.

Programme Information:

This programme funds General Practice consultations and prescriptions for Community Probation Service (CPS) clients with valid CPS vouchers.

One voucher number is valid for one Initial Consult and three Follow-Up appointments.

- Initial Consult – this can be either a 'Full Consult' or a 'Standard Consult'
 - Full Consult
 - A 30-minute appointment. It includes a functional enquiry covering all body systems and mental health, a CVD risk assessment and diabetes screen (if appropriate according to CVDR guidelines), and other standard prevention activities e.g. HPV/ Cervical Smear, Tetanus injection.
 - It is expected that this will be done by GP and nurse.
 - **OR** an extended mental health initial assessment (> 20 minutes)
 - Standard Consult
 - A standard 15-minute appointment.
- Follow-Up Consult – this is a 'Standard Consult'

Programme Objectives:

- To provide funding for CPS clients to access free general practice consultations and prescriptions.
- To provide comprehensive assessments and screening for these patients.

Programme processes:

1. CPS clients receive vouchers from their key worker for free general practice services who numbers the voucher;
2. The client makes an appointment for a Full Consult or a Standard Consult with the practice. If this is for a Full Consult, then the patient requests this when booking the consultation;
3. Appointment Completed.
4. Clinician makes CPS claim via the web portal.
